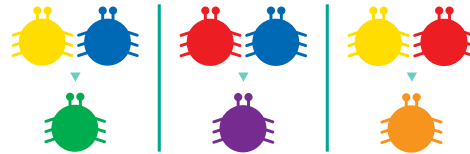
PAINTING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Assemble all your supplies before starting.
- 2 Protect your work surface with a newspaper to catch spills & avoid stains.
- 3 Have a glass of water nearby to rinse your brush & use a paper towel to blot excess water.
- 4 Use a pencil to sketch a design on your pot before painting.

Use this color key to mix new colors to paint with!



- 5 Once you are done decorating your pot, make sure the paint dries thoroughly.
- 6 Next, follow the instructions to plant your marigold seeds!

GROWING INSTRUCTIONS

TIP: Read the instructions thoroughly before starting your project.

- 1 Place peat pellets into a bowl.
- 2 Add 2/3 cup of water to pellets. It may take time for the pellets to absorb water. Help the process by stirring the mixture & breaking up the peat. Pour off any extra water.
- 3 Add all but ½ a cup of the growing medium to your planter.



- 4 Plant half the seed packet on top of the growing medium. Save the extra seeds for future planting.
- 5 Add remaining medium & water thoroughly. Keep medium damp but not soaking.
- 6 Water once a week or when soil is completely dry.
